It includes discograms, lymphangiography, myelography, phlebography, pneumoencephalography and radiation therapy. It also includes removal of tumors (except skin tumors), liver/kidney/bone marrow biopsy, reduction of open bone fractures, amputations, abortions, removal of any gland or organ, plastic surgery, tonsillectomies, adenoidectomies, cesarean sections and any other operation using general anesthesia.
